Red Rye 4.25

Aromas are dark sugar and light spice. Taste is quite sweet, light rye spice at the end

Extra Pale Ale 4.25

It uses lager malt to give lightness of taste and colour, has a lower bitterness than a pale ale but uses new world hops to give it a citrusy finish.

Stewart Brewing

An independent brewery based in Edinburgh, established in 2004, is dedicated to producing hand crafted, premium Scottish Beer.

Edinburgh Gold 4.5

Refreshing, balanced and full of flavour. This is a captivating gold beer, sophisticated in taste and rich in colour.
